WESSEX MALE CHOIR MAKES ITS 2008 DEBUT WITH CHARITY CONCERT IN GLOUCESTERSHIRE

Wessex Male Choir will be performing at a charity concert at the St Peter and St Paul Church in Northleach, Gloucestershire on Saturday 16 February at 7.30pm.

This is the first concert of the year for the award-winning choir and the audience will be entertained with a variety of songs from its repertoire including the stirring 'Do You Hear the People Sing' from the musical Les Miserables, a gospel piece called 'Little Innocent Lamb' and the more contemporary McFly number 'It's All About You'.

Proceeds from the concert will go to the St Peter & St Paul Northleach Charitable Trust to maintain, restore and improve the parish church. The Trust is now working to improve the heating system, repair the porch and low level windows and protect against the recurrence of erosion.

Tickets are priced at £10 for adults and £5 for concessions and can be bought in advance from Fothergills Gallery in Northleach, or on the door. Fothergills is open 9.30am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday and until 4.30pm on Saturday.
